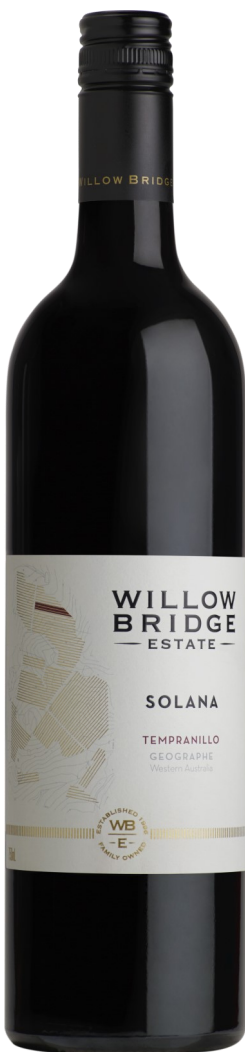

2017 Solana Tempranillo

Estate grown from the spectacular hillside vineyard in the Ferguson Valley of the Geographe wine region, fruit is sourced from the Cameron block which was planted in 2009.

A style which exudes vibrancy and complexity. Distinctive generosity of dark berry fruits with mouth-watering tannin which matches perfectly to food.

Fermented in open top fermenters, hand plunged twice daily at temperatures averaging 28 degrees. Winemaking encourages deep and dense structures, but with spice and minerality.

Variety Tempranillo 100%

Total Acidity 5.2 grams per litre

Fermentation Crushed cool to fermenters to static fermenters for eight days, peak temperature 28 degrees Celsius. 100% barrel matured in new and older french puncheons and hogsheads.

Tasting Note/Flavour Profile

Fresh and lifted, fragrant red and black fruits assisted by anise and black pepper.

Deep, dense wine evolving into flavours of blueberry, raspberry and savoury spice. Long, lingering tannin..

Cellaring

Up to 10 years.
