

WILLOW BRIDGE — ESTATE —

2018 Dragonfly Chenin Blanc

Estate grown from the spectacular hillside vineyard in the Ferguson Valley of the Geographe wine region, fruit is sourced from Forrest block planted in 1998.

Soil is typically a deep layer of ironstone gravelly loam over red and yellow friable clay with slight easterly aspects at elevations of 220 to 250m above sea level.



Winemaking

Variety	Chenin Blanc 100%
Region	Geographe 100%
Alcohol	14.0%
PH	3.24
Total Acidity	6.2 grams per litre
Fermentation	Clean fresh juice fermented in tank to retain freshness and bright fruit aromatics. Winemakers aim to capture the pure Chenin Blanc varietal character. Tank fermentation is maintained at less than 15 degrees celsius, and at ferment completion the wine is cleaned up and bottled.

Tasting Note/Flavour Profile

White citrus flowers complement the striking green apple and honey-suckle aromatics.

Delicious mouth filling palate, medium bodied and soft with flavours of white peach and crispy apple skin.

Cellaring

A wine that looks delightfully fresh and tasty with youth whilst will develop some complexing bottle character for up to ten years.
