When I first opened this I thought it looked 'worked'. It's flinty, lashed with oak, has popcorn aromatics and a general pear-and-cedarwood persona. I thought it was good, but it was hard not to be distracted by the furious paddling of feet. As it breathed though a dazzle of fresh, steely, zippy fruit became more and more apparent, if not predominant. Fruit really does burst out through the finish here in convincing fashion. It's very young, cohesion is still on the build, but it's on the way somewhere very good.
