

# WILLOW BRIDGE — ESTATE —

## *2019 Solana Tempranillo*

Estate grown from the spectacular hillside vineyard in the Ferguson Valley of the Geographe wine region, fruit is sourced from the Cameron block which was planted in 2009.

A style which exudes vibrancy and complexity. Distinctive generosity of dark berry fruits with mouth watering tannin which matches perfectly to food.

Fermented in open top fermenters, hand plunged twice daily at temperatures averaging 28 degrees. Winemaking encourages deep and dense structures, but with spice and minerality.



### **Winemaking**

**Variety** Tempranillo 100%

**Region** Geographe 100%

**Alcohol** 14.0%

**PH** 3.5

**Total Acidity** 5.2 grams per litre

**Fermentation** Crushed cool to static fermenters for eight days, peak temperature 28 degrees Celsius. 100% barrel matured in new and older french puncheons and hogsheads.

### **Tasting Note/Flavour Profile**

Vibrant musk, blueberry and plum with lavender and lifted florals

Complex and textural blend of blackberry fruits woven with bay leaf, black plums and gentle oak. Long and lingering with mouth-watering savoury tannin.

### **Cellaring**

Up to 10 years.
