2020 Dragonfly Chenin Blanc

Estate grown from the spectacular hillside vineyard in the Ferguson Valley of the Geographe wine region, fruit is sourced from Forrest block planted in 1998.

The Dragonfly Chenin Blanc is a wine to enjoy for its pure qualities of fruit and vibrancy.

Mouthfilling and refreshing, a wine exhibiting the varietal characters of Chenin Blanc, zesty citrus, honeysuckle and green apple with the texture and depth.



Winemaking

Variety	Chenin Blanc 100%
Region	Geographe 100%
Alcohol	13.4%

Total Acidity	6.7 grams per litre
Fermentation	Clean fresh juice fermented in tank to retain freshness and bright fruit aromatics. Winemakers aim to capture the pure Chenin Blanc varietal character. Tank fermentation is maintained at less than 15 degrees celsius, and at ferment completion the wine is cleaned up and bottled.

Tasting Note/Flavour Profile

Pale green in colour. Lifted blossom, grapefruit and musk, aromatic and enticing.

Refreshing fruits, soft but concentrated, loads of red apple, pear and musk with a salivating mineral finish.

Cellaring

A wine that looks delightfully fresh and tasty with youth whilst will develop some complexing bottle character for up to ten years.
