

WILLOW BRIDGE — ESTATE —

2020 Water Dancer Cabernet Merlot

Estate grown from the spectacular hillside vineyard in the Ferguson Valley of the Geographe wine region, fruit is sourced predominately from the Blinman blocks which was planted in 1998.

Soil is typically a deep layer of ironstone gravelly loam over red and yellow friable clay with slight westerly aspects at elevations of 220 to 250m above sea level.

Water Dancer typifies the juicy and fleshy expression of the varieties from the Geographe region. A spectrum of flavours ranging from bright berry fruits, to darker plum and lashings of chocolate.

Winemaking technique enhances the aromatic and flavour profile of the varieties whilst maintaining a long fine tannin structure.

Total Acidity	6.4 grams per litre
Fermentation	Crushed cool to fermenters to static fermenters for eight days, peak temperature 28 degrees Celsius. Gently pressed and cellar matured to encourage softness and approachability

Tasting Note/Flavour Profile

Generous lashings of ripe blackberry, plum and dark chocolate.

Fleshy flavoursome palate of bright berry fruits and mocha hints.

Cellaring

Up to 6 years.
